## 10 THINGS TO KNOW

- These crimes affect all members of our communities and are chronically underreported.
  - Offenders must be held accountable for their crimes.
- These crimes disproportionately impact women, LGBTQ+ communities, and racial and ethnic minorities. There are also unique considerations for male victims.
  - Police have an opportunity to **apply proven approaches** that address these complex crimes and comprehensively support victims.
- **Establishing core values** that reinforce the importance of addressing these crimes and supporting victims are critical to a comprehensive response.
  - **Clear policy, ongoing training, and adequate resources** are essential to enhancing the law enforcement response.
- Victims must be supported and included in the criminal justice process on their own terms and their rights must be honored.
  - Deliberate, active **partnerships with outside organizations** and groups enhance the effectiveness and efficiency of police.
- **Performance monitoring and accountability** are vital elements in a comprehensive, data-driven approach to active leadership and organizational and cultural change.
  - **Leadership**, in word and action, is fundamental to enhancing the law enforcement response.
